ABOUT COLLEGE

MANIKCHAND PAHADE LAW COLLEGE, CHH.SAMBHAJINAGAR: A Legacy of Excellence in Education

Manikchand Pahade Law College, the oldest law college in the Marathwada region, was established by the "Marathwada Legal & General Education Society" on the eve of India's States Reorganization. Advocates and educationists like Shri. Kisanrao Wasadikar, Shri. B. G. Ghate, Shri. Shripadrao Newasekar, Mr. Govindbhai Shroff, Late H. G. Vaishnav, and Adv. L. S. Kulkarni founded the society to address the lack of legal education in the region, which previously compelled students to travel to Hyderabad, Nagpur, Pune, or Mumbai. The college is named posthumously after freedom fighter Manikchand Pahade, who played a key role in the Hyderabad Mukti Sangram.

Goals and Vision

The college emphasizes making legal education socially relevant, clinically oriented, and innovative by continually updating pedagogical approaches and aligning with reforms.

Academic Programs

Affiliated with Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University and approved by the Bar Council of India, the college offers: LL.B. (Three Years), BA.LL.B. (Five Years), LL.M. with specializations in Constitutional Law, Criminal Law, and Business Law (recently introduced) and Diploma Courses like Diploma in Taxation Laws, Diploma in Cyber Laws, Diploma in Labour Laws, Diploma in Intellectual Property Laws & Diploma in Medical Jurisprudence.

Infrastructure

Located in the heart of Chhatrapati Sambhajinagar, the 8.29-acre campus houses 16 classrooms, two seminar halls, an administrative building, a playground, an auditorium, a well-equipped library, a computer lab, and a language lab. A new building with additional 8 digital classrooms and a Late Adv. L. S. Kulkarni Memorial Moot Court Hall is existing. The college has Girls and Boys hostel.

Faculty

The college has 09 full-time faculty members, seven of whom hold Ph.D., ensuring quality education.

Co-Curricular and Extracurricular Activities

Moot Courts: The college is organizing the Moot Court Competitions for the past 50 years.

Power Point Competitions: Unique in its nature to stimulate the thinking of students through participants on contemporary legal issues.

Legal Aid: The free Legal Aid Clinic conducts camps and awareness drives, including street plays and poster exhibitions. Recognized by NALSA, the college has received funding for rural legal aid initiatives.

NSS Activities: With 3 NSS units, the college adopts villages for development projects and organizes camps addressing sanitation, literacy, de-addiction, and environmental conservation.

Research and Innovation

The Research Club fosters a research-oriented mindset among students, with major and minor research projects focus on consumer forums and Public Interest Litigations (PILs). The college has hosted national seminars funded by ICSSR on pressing issues like challenges to Indian democracy.


Commitment to Social Responsibility

Moot Problems are invited from all over India from academicians / practitioners /Legal Firms and Law Students scrutinized by a panel of Judges. Last year the college successfully conducted Silver Jubilee Moot Court Competition at National Level.
