# **Report on Guest Lectures 2017-18**

## 1. Interdisciplinary Lecture

The Interdisciplinary Lecture of Dr. Vilas Padhye, Associate Professor and Head, Department of Psychology, Government College, Kolhapur, was organised on the topic 'Emerging Trends in the Subject of Psychology' on 7 October 2017 at our College.
