Report of online State Level Training Programme on Moot Court

On 18th Dec.2021 online State Level Training Programme on Moot Court was conducted with a view to improve students' knowledge about moot court. Virtual platform Cisco Webex was used for this training programme. Total 523 students had registered for this programme.
