REPORT OF NSS ACTIVITIES

2015-2016

(Jun to Nov)

The college has invited the names from students to participate in NSS Regular activities as volunteers. The college received 275 names of students to participate in the unit as volunteers. The theme of the regular NSS activities for this academic year is "betterment and enrichment of environment and helping society through the water harvesting and allied activities". Student volunteers participated in this activity with great enthusiasm and interest.

On 17/07/2015 the selection round was organized in consultation with principal and faculty members. *Prof. Amol D. Chavhan, Prof. Shital S. Barhate* NSS Programme coordinators conducted this round. Out of 275 students, 200 spirited and enthusiastic students were selected and were registered as NSS volunteer on 22/07/2015.

Regular Activities

International Yoga Day
