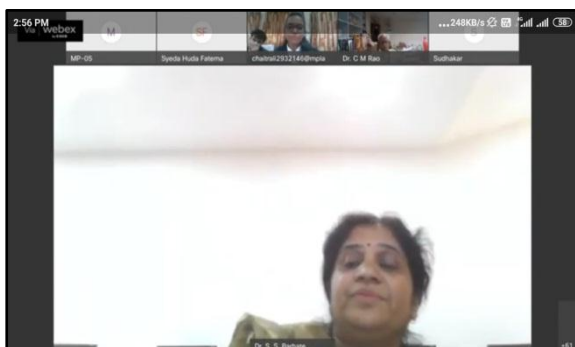
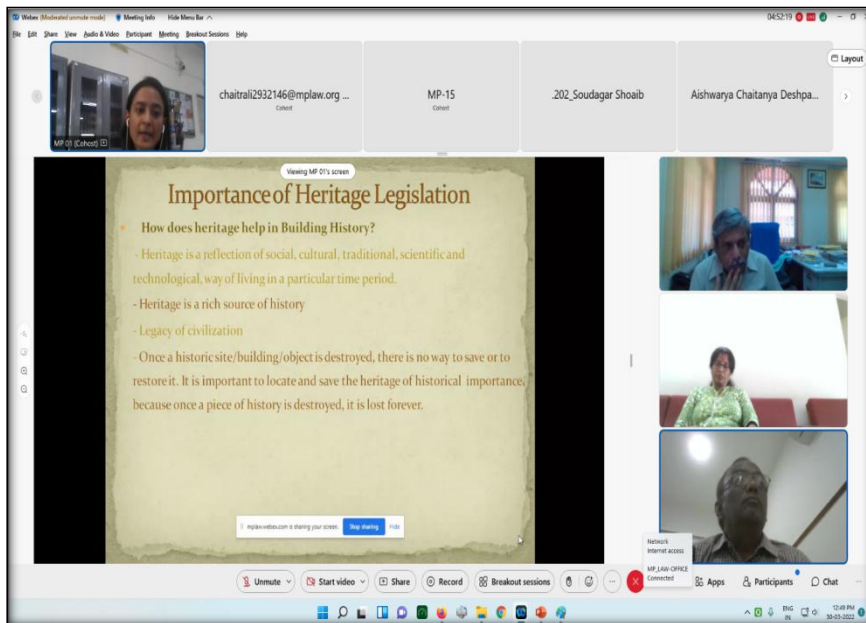
Valedictory function:
