- 1 The details of Anti ragging Mission has been given vide reach by publishing it in the prospectus of the institution. It contains the instruction and warning of prohibiting the ragging, Anti ragging Mission Statement, punishment for ragging and Anti ragging helpline numbers at the institution in English and Marathi languages.
- 2 The mentoring Cell for the freshers students consisting of Lower Level Mentor and Higher Level Mentor students from seniors for helping the freshers were established.
- 3 The college has installed the CCTV in college premise.
- 4 The Anti-ragging Mission boards exhibiting the warning about not involvement in ragging act, Anti-ragging Committee and Squad, punishment of ragging, helpline numbers, contact numbers of functionaries of college are already displayed in college campus.
- 5 The Guardian/class teachers were appointed to all classes and they were involved in promoting the fraternity among the students in respective classes.
- 6 The Students Co-ordination Committee and healthy interaction committee, of students were constituted at college.
- 7 The Parents Meting was organised on 11/08/2014. Adv. S. M. Patel, representative of parents delivered a guiding speech to the audience.
- 8 The meeting of the Anti-ragging Mission in Boys and Girls hostels were organised and the objectives of the Anti-ragging Mission were introduced by Professor in-charge.
- 9 The anti-ragging subjects were given to the students in different competitions like Elocution, Debate, Extempore speech and Rangolietc, during the annual social gathering of college.
