

This Seminar was organized to create, awareness and sensitivity about Human rights and to have discussion and deliberation about Human rights and Criminal Justice System amongst students, faculty, advocates and others. The Seminar was inaugurated with the inaugural

address by **Hon'ble Justice Smt. Sadhana Jadhav**, Former Judge , High Court of Bombay , **Dr. C.M. Rao**, Principal presided over the inaugural session . The Seminar was inaugurated with the special presence of **Adv.Dr. Kalpalata Patil Bharaswadkar** , Secretory , ML&GE Society .

In the beginning of this event, the preamble of the Indian Constitution was read over, the Welcome address was delivered by Mr. S.N. Morey Vice Principal and the event was introduced Dr. Aparna Kottapalle, Research Club and IQAC Coordinator. Inaugural address was delivered by Hon'ble Justice Smt. Sadhana Jadhav, Judge



Bombay High Court of Judicature during which madam spoke on judicial contribution in protecting Human Rights in Criminal Justice System in India. Hon'ble Madam referred to many cases decided by Apex Court and High Courts including the cases which were decided by her. At the end of the inaugural session Q& A Session was conducted in which Hon'ble Justice Sadhana Jadhav answered the queries of the participants. The 1<sup>st</sup> inaugural session was Anchored by Ms. Amruta Kaur Johar and the vote of thanks was proposed by Ms. Chinmai Deshpande, faculty. The Presidential Address for the inaugural Session was delivered by **Dr. C. M. Rao** *Principal* of the College, while delivering the presidential address Dr. Rao congratulated participants and appreciated the content delivered.



The Second Session was on the theme "Human Rights foundations of Criminal Law" in which **Dr.**Shampa Dev Professor of Law, School of Law, Christ Deemed to be University, Bangalore acted as resource person. During the session Dr. Shampa preferred to discuss on theoretical and jurisprudential dimensions and further National and International documentations and the cases which were linked with the discussion such as

Virendra Khanna V. State of Karnataka 2020, CBI V. Mukesh Kumar Sharma 2021. She further initiated the philosophical debate in the mind of participants about justice and rights from the lenses of common good. This session also was followed by Q&A Session. This session was anchored by Ms. Uma Shinde, Faculty and Vote of Thanks were proposed by Mr. Praddyumna Shastri, Faculty.

The third Session was on "Criminal Justice System: The Role of advocates in Protecting Human Rights" in which Adv. Dr. Rajendra Anabhule, Advocate Pune acted as resource person. While delivering the session Adv. Anabhule gave references of the tasks which he had undertaken as an advocate as filing of PIL and getting information under RTI, the pedagogy which he had followed while initiating the process for moulding the laws and execution of the same. proposed by Mr. Hemant Morey. This session was also followed by Q&A.

After these sessions three participants Viz. Dr. Amit Singh, Ms. Shradhha Kapadane Mr.

Principal M.P. Law College.

Total 683 participants had registered and 315 attended this Seminar online including students,

faculty, advocates, and people from other different streams all over India.

been achieved.
