Para legal services

The Syllabus of BA. LL.B. IV and LL.B. II consists of ADRS course hence to equip students with the practical working of DLSA and Mediation centre the Study visit was organised District Legal Services Authority, Aurangabad on 08-04-2022. During this visit Total 150 students from BA.LLB IV and LLB II year participated. The teacher's viz. Dr. S.G. Shirsat and Dr. S.S. Barhate accompanied the students. All the students were taken to the office of DLSA , chambers of panel advocates i.e. trained mediators. They were made known of the practice and procedure followed in the working of the office by the Office staff. They also observed on-going mediation proceeding with the permission of the authorities.

It was decided in the beginning of the academic year to organise para legal training workshop. Considering this visit of students to DLSA and in consultation with Secretary, DLSA they were acquainted with the same immediately after the visit. Special Orientation Programme was arranged for the students in the conference Hall of the Court to acquaint students about Para Legal Training and role of a Para Legal Volunteers, allied areas including Mediation and stages of trial .

For this interactive Orientation programme Hon'ble Smt. R.S. Nimbalkar, District Judge, Hon'ble Smt. Vaishali Phadnis, Secretary, DLSA, Aurangabad , Adv. Ashok Thakre, trained mediator and Advocate, Aurangabad, were present to guide the students. The programme commenced with the recitation of the Preamble of the Constitution of India. Thereafter, Dr. Shital S.



Barhate, Subject teacher of ADR, introduced the event to the audience. In the beginning, Adv. Ashok Thakre spoke on the art of mediation and conciliation. He also highlighted the qualities of a good mediator with the referring to few cases handled by him as a trained mediator. Thereafter, Hon'ble Smt. R.S. Nimbalkar, District Judge 5, in her address discussed various stages in the criminal trial.

Hon'ble Smt. Vaishali Phadnis, Secretary, DLSA, Aurangabad, guided students on role of District Legal Services Authority and its actual functioning. She also highlighted the role and importance of Para- legal volunteers.
