

Anti – ragging Mission Report on activities 2011 – 12

The College has taken following steps during 2011 - 12 for the compliance of UGC Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009. The Anti-ragging committee and Anti-ragging squad are already established in the academic year 2010-11.

1. The details of Anti – ragging Mission has been given wide reach by publishing it in the prospectus of the institution. It contains the instruction and warning of prohibiting the ragging, Anti – ragging Mission Statement, punishment for ragging and Anti – ragging helpline numbers at the institution in English and Marathi languages.
2. The undertaking by students regarding non-involvement in ragging act is introduced in admission process.
3. On the eve of foundation day and freshers welcome function on August 1, 2011 the students are made aware of Anti – ragging Mission of the institution by Prof. Shrikishan Morey.
4. As per the direction of UGC the Anti – ragging video show was organised on August 3, 2011. The freshers and seniors students in large numbers were participated in this activity.

5. The representatives of students Mr. Avinash Suryavanshi, Miss Prachi Paralikar and Mr. Nikhil Dube, Miss Mrunal Kolhe are nominated on the Anti – ragging Committee and Anti-ragging Squad respectively for the academic year 2011-12.
6. The Mentoring Cell is constituted with Prof. S. G. Shirsat, Prof. Shampa Dev, and Prof. D. B. Kolte as teacher co-ordinators and consisting of four higher level mentors and nineteen lower level mentors as per UGC rules 2009 to each group of six students according to the strength of freshers in Pre law – I yr.
7. The healthy interaction committee is constituted with Prof. Dr. Aparna Kottapalle as teacher co-ordinator, four faculty members and representatives of students from each class.

8. The Students Co-ordination Committee consisting of Mis. Sarja Shaikh as students co-ordinator and students members of all committees constituted under Anti-ragging Mission as members is constituted for having co-ordination of the Anti-ragging activity.
9. On the occasion of Foundation day (i.e August 23, 2011) of Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, the Anti-ragging play performed by students was exhibited. As part of foundation day celebration the essay and drawing competition was organised on the Anti-ragging topics – 'चला बंधुभावाने शिकूया, जीवन आपले घडवूया !' and 'रॅगिंग नकोरे बाबा !'
10. The 'Parents – teachers – counsellor – freshers Meet' was organised on September 20, 2011. Mr. Sandeep Jadhav (Dy. S. P. Aurangabad) and Prof. Dr. Padhye (Educational Psychologist and Professor, Government College, Aurangabad) had delivered speeches and provided guidance on 'the issue of ragging and role of parents and teachers in anti-ragging mission', and 'the effects of ragging on personality of students and remedies thereon' respectively. The parents, teachers and freshers had actively participated in this meet.
